Flautist Pascale Margely is a graduate of the Conservatoire de musique du Québec in Gatineau and is active in the musical scene in the Outaouais. She teaches at the Conservatoire de musique du Québec in Gatineau and the École de musique de l'Outaouais; works freelance as an interpreter for the Théâtre Lyrique de Hull, Espace musique and the Ponticello Concerts; and organizes her own chamber music concerts with various groups. Ms. Margely is very interested in contemporary Canadian music and has interpreted several important Canadian works. She has frequently collaborated with composer Jan Järvillepp to create new works such as the Concerto 2000 with the Orchestre du Conservatoire de musique du Québec in Gatineau. In 2001, she received a scholarship from the Conseil des arts et des lettres du Québec, enabling her to go to the Mozarteum of Salzburg in Austria to study with Mr. Roberto Fabbriciani.
