A native of Halifax, Nova Scotia, Marc Djokic is known for his powerful and virtuosic performances. His engaging, anecdotal and down-to-earth approach has made him a fan favourite of audiences. Praised for his “rhythmic sense and natural phrasing” by La Presse, Mr. Djokic is able to reach out to a diverse audience through his range of repertoire, new concert formats and collaborations. He first studied violin with his winner of Quebec’s Prix Opus and Canada Council’s Instrument Bank among numerous other prizes, he performs frequently as soloist with Canada’s top orchestras and in chamber music festivals across North America. Mr. Djokic also teaches masterclasses at universities and summer music festivals. He performs on a rare Guarnerius violin from 1740, a Carl Becker from 1927 and a Hannibal Fagnola from 1922, and he is particular about choosing the right violin for the occasion!
